

# Terroir by Ant Moore Pinot Noir



**VINTAGE:** 2013

**GRAPE VARIETY:** Pinot Noir

**GROWING REGION:** Central Otago

**TASTING NOTES:** Terroir is the story of how grapes from the same region, valley and sometimes even vineyard can vary in their growth and palate. The weather, microclimate, soil types and diurnal temperatures all have a hand in determining a grape specific personality that vigneron and winemaker must mould and caress to get the best wine.

The nose exhibits aromas of strawberry, ripe cherry, dry spice, and a hint of earthy notes. The palate shows concentrated red fruit with underlining savoury flavours. The tannins are fine but persistent in the palate, finishing with an integrated oak, and great length.

This wine contains a mixture of traditional Pinot Noir clones 777, 115, Abel and 667. It was made through minimal handling, intervention, and the softest touch.

**COLOUR:** Ruby

**CELLARING:** Drinking well upon release, this wine can be enjoyed young and will continue to mature.
